## Third transnational meeting

Hosted by University of Turku

On the 9th and 10th of May 2023, the consortium of C-DISK project organized its second transnational meeting in Turku, Finland.

During the meeting, the partners presented the previous steps of the PRI/AI output and planned the upcoming steps for the finalisation of the C-Disk digital skills model.

The results of the survey, conducted in each partner country, were presented, with a detailed analysis and the statistical correlations concerning age, gender, and role soon to be shared with the target group.

In addition, the upcoming tasks and responsibilities have been discussed and partners are working on the next results.

## Upcoming tasks and events:

Each partner committed to realise the focus groups in Their countries with 10 representatives of the target group.

The C-Disk digital skills model will be finalised in the light of the results of the focus groups.

The development of the assessment and the training toolkit will begin in June.

## What is next for C-DISK Project

In the next months, the partners will focus on the elaboration of the SELF-ASSESSMENT SERVICE OF THE DEGREE OF UNDERSTANDING OF DIGITAL SKILLS.

This tool will be available to the two different target groups (students and workers).

For the students the self-assessment will be an opportunity to become aware of their level of preparation for a digitized labour market; for the workers will represent a reference for sizing one's skills gap and for planning one's professional development.

This important task will be completed through the following activities:

1. defining the technical specifications and conceptual design of the platform;
2. developing the platform, uploading the content and graphic solutions;
3. technical testing of the platform and conducting pilot actions in all partner countries in order to collect feedback for the finetuning of the service.
